GRASS COURTS

Work continues on the grass courts in preparation for the season ahead. Look out for an e-mail confirming their opening in May. Once open, the courts will initially be playable from 1 pm until 8.30 pm daily. Please *do not* play on them outside the opening or closing times as displayed on the sign near the courts, or if they are wet. This will damage them and undo all the groundsman's hard work.

HARD COURTS / SCHOOL USE

The hard courts have been power washed and will be repainted soon. To help maintain them in good condition please keep them clear of any debris or rubbish and play on them only in proper tennis shoes with non-marking soles.

The excellent arrangement we have with the school gives them use of both courts from 12 noon to 4 pm in term time but check our website for the precise times which may be slightly different. Please do not do anything to jeopardise this arrangement.

Work continues on the nearby development of Hampstead Manor and there may be some disruption on weekdays during working hours.

WATER

We have had a tough challenge this winter as a result of a water leak. As yet, we have been unable to find exactly where the old Victorian water pipe enters the club from Croftway and so have been unable to fix the problem. We are continuing to work on this but at present we can only turn the water on for short periods of time. Bottled drinking water will be available free of charge in the clubhouse and we would ask you to use as little water as possible until a solution has been found.
